

## Job Opportunity: SUMMER PROGRAMMER

## What we are looking for:

An enthusiastic, creative person that can plan and facilitate fun activities for children of various ages. This person likes kids and is responsible for providing a safe experience for those attending library programs. Previous experience working with children is an asset. This person can shop for program supplies and stay within a budget. Also, they will be a role model for children – besides demonstrating their positive attributes, they should be a reader! We want this person to promote and role model reading to kids.

## Minimum Requirements:

- Between the ages of seventeen and thirty
- Have a tidy appearance and a friendly demeanor
- Have a vehicle and driver's license or access to a ride
- · Competent literacy skills and digital skills
- Employment is subject to a criminal record check and a children's services intervention record check
- Must have a valid social insurance number, be a Canadian citizen or permanent resident, and be legally entitled to work in Canada

## **Physical Requirements:**

This person may be required to lift objects occasionally that weigh up to 20lbs. To ensure the safety of the children attending programs, this person must be able to watch and keep up with children indoors and out. They must also be able to work with paints, glues and other substances. Manual dexterity is required.
